

The Level 3 Diploma for Residential Childcare is designed to equip learners with the knowledge, understanding and skills required to work in a residential childcare setting.

This is the recommended qualification that meets Ofsted requirements.

Duration on Programme

• 12 - 18 months depending on experience.

Residential Childcare Level 3 Diploma (RQF)
