

The Level 5 Diploma in Leadership and Management for Residential Childcare RQF is designed to equip learners with the knowledge, understanding and skills required to work in a management role within a residential childcare setting.

Duration on Programme

 12 - 18 months depending on experience. (Needs to be working in a Deputy or Management position).

Programme Delivery

- Tailored sessions to meet learner needs.
- · Self-Study.
- 1-2-1 monthly sessions to provide feedback and guidance.
- Observations, professional discussions and feedback.



Costs

- All prices are based on individual cost per learner.

Overview

Delivery options will be based on an individual basis but will include a combination of the items listed.



Tailored sessions to meet learner needs.



1-2-1 sessions – the non-face-to-face sessions can be remote, or they can be adjusted based on learner needs.





Face-to-face sessions – timetabled in advance with the manager.
